Academic Ineligibility Appeal

Students with grades that result in a GPA below a 2.0 and/or are not passing 20 units at the grading period (quarter/semester) are academically ineligible until the next grading period. Only courses offered in the Conejo Valley Unified School District, or the school district from which a student has transferred, will be considered for co-curricular eligibility.

Process and Procedures for an Academic Probationary Period

- 1) Academically ineligible students apply for a one time academic eligibility waiver by filling out the Co-Curricular Academic Eligibility Petition and turning it in to the Athletic Office within 5 school days of the student being notified that they are ineligible.
- 2) The Co-Curricular Appeals Committee meets to determine if a probationary period is to be granted.
- 3) All students may continue to practice with the team, but not compete in any contest, while they await the disposition of the appeal. If the petition for a probationary period is denied, continued practice or involvement with the team will be determined by the Athletic Director and the head coach of that sport.
- 4) If the petition for a probationary period is granted, the academically ineligible student is immediately eligible for competition for the remainder of the grading period. At the end of the probationary period, continuing eligibility will be based on the GPA at the next grading period (quarter/semester).
- 5) Deliberations and proceedings of the Co-Curricular Appeals Committee are confidential. All decisions will be communicated to the student and parent(s)/guardian by the Assistant Principal/Athletic Director.

General Information: The Conejo Valley Unified School District Administrative Regulation 6145 requires that all students who participate in organized co-curricular activities must have maintained a 2.0 grade point average during all grading periods (progress reports, quarter, and term report cards). The CVUSD and NPHS administration know that there are “extenuating circumstances” for some students. This policy also allows students who are academically ineligible to petition for reconsideration of their eligibility. A student is granted a waiver of the academic eligibility requirement ***only one time throughout his/her four-year high school career.***
